Notes by the Charity Trustees :

1) We THANK YOU for your financial support. By signing this Declaration you help us make the most of your donations by allowing us to recover from the Inland Revenue the tax you have paid them on your Gift Aid donations to us ;

2) Please note that you must be a United Kingdom taxpayer and in the financial year covering your donations you must be paying an amount of income tax and /or capital gains tax at least equal to the tax that the Charity reclaims on your donations in the tax year ;

3) If in the future your circumstances change and you no longer pay income tax / or capital gains tax equal to the tax that the Charity is reclaiming on your donations, you should cancel your Gift Aid declaration ;

4) You can cancel the declaration at any time in writing to the Charity. The declaration will then not apply to donations you make on or after the date of cancellation, or such later date as you specify ;

5) *Please notify the Charity if you change your name and address while your Gift Aid declaration is in force ;*

6) If you pay tax at the higher rate you can claim further tax relief in your Self Assessment tax return;

7) If you are unsure whether your donations qualify for Gift Aid tax relief, please ask the Charity's Treasurer. Or you can ask your local tax office for leaflet IR113 Gift Aid.
